Project Description:

Frontier Stone, LLC proposes a new, 215.5 ± acre dolomite/limestone quarry on a 269.45 ± acre parcel located in the Town of Shelby, Orleans County about 3.7 miles south of the Village of Medina. A notice describing the project, availability of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS), and the complete application materials was published in the Environmental Notice Bulletin on April 2, 2014 at: http://www.dec.ny.gov/enb/20140402_not8.html and circulated to various agencies and interested individuals. This notice also announced a written comment period through May 12, 2014.

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYS DEC) has determined to extend the written public comment period deadline on the above-referenced permit applications and Draft EIS from May 12, 2014 to June 9, 2014.

Positive Declaration

Monroe County - The Penfield Town Board, as lead agency, has determined that the proposed Southpoint Marina Expansion may have a significant adverse impact on the environment and a Draft Environmental Impact Statement must be prepared. The Final Scoping Outline is available to the public on the Town's website at www.penfield.org.

The action involves an application to expand the Southpoint Marina with the installation of an additional 176 boat slips to the existing 186 slips, along with the construction of a 2,700 square foot clubhouse seasonal dining area and swimming pool to serve the marina at the south end of Irondequoit Bay. The project is located at 1384 and 1420 Empire Boulevard in the Town of Penfield, New York.
