In accordance with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (New York State DEC) policy on Contact, Cooperation, and Consultation with Indian Nations (CP-42), I am writing to let you know about a proposal currently under review by our Department. As described in the enclosed notice, and electronic copy of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS), the proposal involves the construction of a new stone quarry on approximately 270 acres located in the Town of Shelby, Orleans County

By way of background, our agency has determined the applications for the above referenced proposed project to be complete and has accepted the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS) as being adequate for public review. We will also be conducting a public hearing at the Town of Shelby Town Hall, located at 4062 Salt Works Road, Medina, New York, on Wednesday, April 30th, at 6:00 PM to receive public comment on the applications and Draft EIS. In addition, written public comments will be accepted by the Department on the Draft EIS and permit application documents until May 12, 2014.
